Introduction

Love and Other Objects is a reading of letters that are based on true experiences and memories of love. This production that moved beyond the proscenium theatre format was performed in the open space of the Goethe-Institut of Sri Lanka.

Production Design

This performance differed from a conventional play. It was designed in the form of an intimate conversation between the people of the performance: performers and the audience.

Costume Design

The audience and the performers were on the same level and the costuming was done to allow no distinction between them. It was decided that the cast will be dressed in their daily clothes. Each cast member wore casual clothing in a selected colour.

Light design

No special stage lighting was used since it was a performance where the audience and the performers are seated on an equal level to read love letters. The lights available in the performance space were used to ensure that the crowd could see one another.

Set


The performance space was arranged to allow comfortable seating as well as wide and easy visibility of the performance and performers to the audience and vice versa.

Makeup

The form of the performance did not require special makeup.


Space & Atmosphere

Because the performance took the shape of a sharing of letters about love with a group of people, a letter with their own name on it was a given to each audience member instead of a ticket and a friendly welcome was arranged. The arrangement allowed the performers and audience to sit in the same space, move about freely upon entering the space and drink some beer or wine if they preferred to. Bowls of chocolate were placed in this space and they were freely available for everyone.



Publicity Design

For publicity design we opted to go for cartoons illustrated by Piumi Wijesundara for a light-hearted and approachable feel for the performance. Given that the performance was based on love letters, the posters were designed as envelopes addressed to the audience, with caricatures of some of the types of characters that were portrayed in the letters in the performance.


